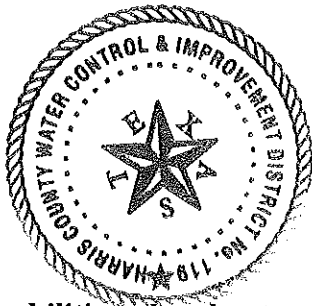
The meeting will be held on Monday, January 9, 2017, at 5:00 p.m.

The subject of the meeting will be to consider and take such actions as the Board may deem appropriate in connection with the following:


1. Comments from the public;
2. Approval of the minutes of the December 12, 2016, Board of Directors meeting;
3. Report on status of collection of taxes, the status of collection of delinquent tax accounts, and the payment of invoices in connection therewith, and the taking of any actions required in connection therewith, including authorizing the termination of water service to the properties of delinquent taxpayers;
4. Adoption of Resolution Authorizing an Additional Penalty on Delinquent Personal Property Taxes and authorize delinquent tax attorney to collect delinquent personal property taxes beginning April 1, 2017, including the filing of lawsuits, as necessary;
5. Report on District's water, sanitary sewer and storm sewer systems, including:
 - a) Customer appeals of District charges or policies;
 - b) Compliance with District permits;
 - c) Authorizing the repair and maintenance of District facilities, including repair or replacement of booster pump #2; and
 - d) Authorizing delinquent accounts to be turned over for collection or written off;
6. Proposal for providing detention pond maintenance services, and the taking of any actions required in connection therewith;
7. Authorize operator to provide required information to districts receiving water through emergency interconnect relative to Consumer Confidence Reports;
8. Recess to Executive Session to discuss: real property matters pursuant to §551.072, Texas Government Code;
9. Proposal for ESD 16 to purchase of Water Plant No. 1 from District, and the taking of any actions required in connection therewith;
10. Status of North Harris County Regional Water Authority, and the taking of any actions required in connection therewith;
11. (a) Authorizing the design, advertisement for bids and/or award of construction contracts or concurrence in the award of contracts for the construction of water, sanitary sewer and drainage facilities within the District;
 - (ii) approve plans and specifications and authorize advertisement for bids for wastewater system rehabilitation project; and

- (iii) approve plans and specifications and authorize advertisement for bids for demolition of Water Plant No. 1;
 - (b) Status of construction contracts and the approval of any change orders and/or acceptance of facilities for operation and maintenance purposes:
 - (i) status of contract with The Trey Evans Co. for Water Plant No. 3 recoating;
- 12. Acceptance of site and/or easement conveyances for facilities constructed or to be constructed for the District, and the taking of any actions required in connection therewith;
- 13. Report regarding the status of development of property within the District, and the taking of any actions required in connection therewith;
- 14. Review preliminary cost summary and authorize preparation of Bond Application Report for District's Series 2017 Bonds, and the taking of any actions required in connection therewith;
- 15. Requests for issuance of utility commitments, and the taking of any actions required in connection therewith;
- 16. Financial and investment reports, including invoices presented, and the taking of any actions required in connection therewith, including authorizing the payment of invoices present;
- 17. Adoption of Resolution Adopting List of Qualified Brokers Authorized to Engage in Investment Transactions with District;
- 18. Consider status of web site maintenance and the taking of any actions required in connection therewith, including authorizing posting of District agendas on website; and
- 19. Matters for possible placement on future agendas.
